

RESOLUTION OF THE CENTRAL ELECTION COMMISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

ON THE FORMATION OF POLLING STATIONS AT DIPLOMATIC MISSIONS AND CONSULAR OFFICES OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN IN FOREIGN STATES

In accordance with Articles 10, 14 and 16 of the Electoral Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan and based on the submission of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the formation of polling stations for the election of deputies to the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan

D E C I D E S:

1. To establish 53 polling stations for the election of deputies to the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan at diplomatic missions and consular offices of the Republic of Uzbekistan in foreign states according to the annex.

2. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan: to make a proposal on the registration of polling stations opened in foreign states to the constituencies for the election of deputies to the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan; ensure the creation of necessary conditions for polling stations at diplomatic missions and consular offices of the Republic of Uzbekistan in foreign states; to inform, through the mass media and other means (taking into account local conditions), citizens living in foreign states about polling stations abroad, citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan about the terms and procedure for inclusion in the list of voters of the election commission abroad, about the days of early voting and the day of elections ;

create the possibility of electronic appeal for inclusion in the voters list to citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan living in foreign countries, through the official website of the ministry; regularly, through the Dunyo News Agency, to cover in the media the activities of polling stations at diplomatic missions and consular offices of the Republic of Uzbekistan in foreign states; in order to create amenities for citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan, together with the Ministry of Investment and Foreign Trade, the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations of the Republic of Uzbekistan, additionally study the need to create new polling stations abroad in other cities of foreign countries, and, if necessary, make a submission in the prescribed manner and terms to the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

3. The Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Uzbekistan together with the Uzbekistan Airways Joint-Stock Company to ensure timely delivery of equipment and documents related to the elections to the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan, to diplomatic missions and consular offices of the Republic of Uzbekistan in foreign states, as well as the delivery of these documents to assigned constituencies.

4. To entrust the Secretariat of the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the provision of equipment, literature and documents related to the elections, polling stations at diplomatic missions and consular offices of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

5. To publish this resolution on the official website of the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

6. The control over the implementation of this resolution shall be assigned to the deputy chairman of the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan M. Istamov.
